Mt Maria College

This education construction project unites the two colleges (primary and secondary) on the same campus building a sense of community and uniting the groups of buildings respectfully considering the heritage of buildings.

The college community is excited by the completion of the building, which features geothermal heating and cooling system, utilising ground temperature to either reject heat in summer or collect heat in winter.

The project features nine new learning spaces for the middle school, including large group presentation spaces and a performing arts area.



Nudgee College

The Hanly Learning Centre is located prominently at the centre of the college a move that raises the profile of academia in a sports-driven secondary boys' school. The project was completed in two stages including a three storey learning centre and Edmund Rice Mall.



All Hallows
